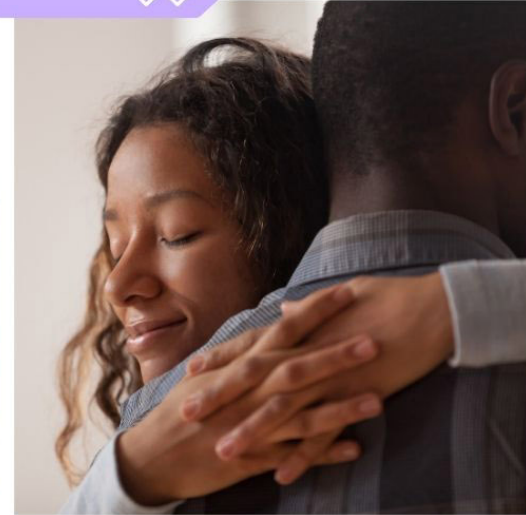

FOR CAREGIVERS AND YOUTH AGES 10-14**

SAAF is a culturally tailored, family-centered intervention for African American youths ages 10 to 14 and their primary caregivers. SAAF's goal is to prevent substance use and behavior problems among youth by strengthening positive family interactions, preparing youths for teen years, and enhancing caregivers' efforts to help youths reach positive goals.

Youth who participated in SAAF demonstrated fewer conduct problems, and were less likely to start using drugs!
