Free toothbrushes, toothpaste, period products, shampoo, deodorant and more.

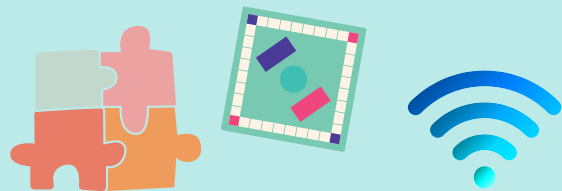
