Applications must be submitted in time to be reviewed by the Grant Committee. The Grant Committee will meet to review all applications submitted. Our recommendations will then be presented to the full Board of Directors for final approval.

It is the intention of C.A.P.T. to issue grants not to exceed \$500.00. Applications will be judged on individual merit.
