POSITION: Pool Maintenance Mechanic

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Pool Maintenance Mechanic shall maintain, perform service, emergency repairs, installations, diagnostic repairs, routine preventative maintenance to the swimming pool and Senior High School HVAC and plumbing systems:

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must hold "Certified Pool Operator" certificate and pesticide certification for the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, Category 24 – Aquatics.
- Previous experience in servicing aquatics, HVAC and plumbing equipment and systems required.
- Must be capable of reading and comprehending technical manuals related to the pool equipment to properly operate and service pool equipment.
- Must be able to demonstrate manual dexterity to operate a variety of hand tools and test equipment associated with the Pool Maintenance Mechanic's daily routine.
- Must be capable of distinguishing shades of color to perform pool chemistry testing.
- Must possess a valid Pennsylvania Driver's License with a clean driving record.
- Employee will work under the direction of the Director of Facilities or his/her designee.
- Must be able to demonstrate through testing the ability to lift at least fifty (50) pounds without assistance and one hundred (100) pounds with help, capable of working from ladders of varying height, and physically capable of continuous walking, moving, climbing, carrying, bending, kneeling, crawling, reaching and handling, sitting, standing, pushing and pulling as required to perform all duties.
