Three Ways to Log Your Reading


1. QR Code

Each student has a bookmark with a QR code that links directly to the reading submission page. A smartphone, Chromebook, or any computer with a camera can be used. To access a QR code reader on the Chromebooks, follow these steps.

1. Click on "Elementary Resources" on the Chromebook homepage



2. Click on "QR Code Scanner" in the bottom left



- 3. You might need to click "allow" to give the website access to the camera.
- 4. Show the camera the QR code.
- 5. Click the link that appears on the computer screen.
